

ANNUAL REPORT 2023-24

1. ANO Captain Harsha Kumar received a DDG commendation from the former Chief Minister of Karnataka, Sri Basavaraj Bommai, in recognition of his excellent work within the NCC organization.
2. The 77th Independence Day celebration took place at JSS Polytechnic, Mysore. On this auspicious day, the flag was hoisted by Sri Bhaktavatsala, Principal of JSS Polytechnic, Mysore, along with ANO Captain Harsha Kumar and Subedar Madhukumar G K of 1 KAR Engineer Company NCC, on August 15, 2023.
